- Unwanted theatre, concert and show tickets

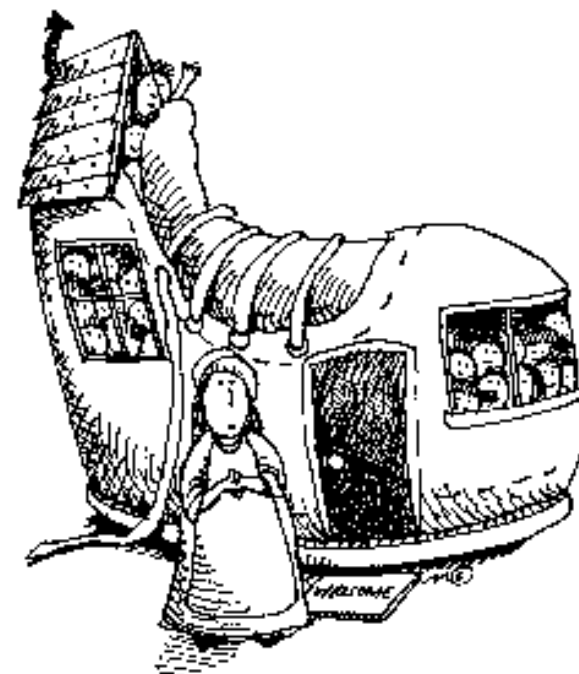
Plus all those items money cannot buy!! As detailed already
