	<p><b><u>Applications.</u></b></p> <p><b>Application No. 10/00573/FUL.</b> Conversion of existing single dwelling into two semi detached 4-bed dwellings with part single/part two storey rear extension, loft conversion with rear dormer window and summer house and car port.  <b>Location:</b> 26 High Street, Stock.  <b>Applicant:</b> Mr A. McGurren.  The Parish Council commented that care should be taken to preserve the Conservation Area. Any planning applications within the Conservation Area should take into account the design aspects included in the Village Design Statement Draft and be mindful of the heritage that pertains in that part of the village. The `third floor' extension at the back of the building would be visible from the front of the building and somewhat overpowering.</p> <p><b>Application No. 10/00610/CLEUD.</b> Use of land as residential garden.  <b>Location:</b> Birley Cottage, Stock Road, Stock.  <b>Applicant:</b> Mr Barry Barnes.  The Parish Council had no comments to make and stated that it is purely for the Planning Officer to determine the legality of the application based on the evidence submitted.</p> <p><b>Application No. 10/00616/FUL.</b> Alterations to front bay window.  <b>Location:</b> 3 Mill Lane, Stock.  <b>Applicant:</b> Mr. Hopkins.  The Parish Council had no comments to make.</p> <p><b><u>Chelmsford Borough Council Decisions</u></b></p> <p><b><u>Applications for Works to be carried out on trees in Conservation Area and trees that have Tree Preservation Orders.</u></b></p> <p><b>Application No. 10/05064/TPO.</b> G2 - Oaks x 7 - on western boundary, adjacent to Well Lane - clean out dead wood only under DDD (TPO 2009/088).  <b>Location:</b> Scriveners Farm, Madles Lane, Stock.  <b>Applicant:</b> Mr Steve Quincy.
